This quilt finishes at 66” x 82”.

Ingredients (we will make 20 blocks):

1	Jelly Roll	Ombre Confetti Metallic by Vanessa Christenson for Moda
1/2	Yard	Modafactions Metallic White – 9884 11M <i>Corner squares that need to be light or can be the background</i>
1/2	Yard	Modafactions Metallic Jet – 9884 26M
3 3/4	Yards	Moda Bella Solid White – 9900 98 <i>Background fabric</i>
4	Yards	Your favorite Confetti Metallic Print – 10807 <i>Backing fabric</i>

Prints:

- set aside 20 strips 2 1/2 “ x wof – one of each color
- from each *matching* strip cut **2** – 2 1/2” squares and **2** – 2 1/2” x 18 1/2” strips
- set aside the 18 1/2” strips for a scrappy binding

From your background:

- cut **20** – 2 1/2” x wof strips and set aside
- cut **6** – 6 1/2” x wof strips and set aside
- cut **82** – 2 1/2” x 6 1/2” rectangles
- cut **80** – 2 1/2” squares

From black:

- cut **3** – 2 1/2” x wof strips and set aside
- cut **31** – 2 1/2” squares
